A Volunteer Brings Joy: Thank You Kathy Paulin!

Three times a year, on Cinco de Mayo, Halloween and Christmas, Kathy Paulin funnels candy into piñatas for the daily attendees at Catholic Charities' Adult Day Center. Known as Piñata

Days, this was one of the first activities Kathy implemented when she started volunteering six years ago. After years of donating, she made it her goal to give back in new ways with the gift of time and immediately knew the Adult Day Center was the right place, commenting on her first time at ADC, "I think they saw my face light up."

Kathy's commitment of a few hours every Monday for the last six years has provided her with countless memories of her time at the ADC. Just as her treats and games inspire smiles from those at the center, their kindness and delight can't help but motivate Kathy to return every week. She understands the impact that Catholic Charities has for our neighbors with special needs and has formed lasting relationships with

both members of the Adult Day Center and staff. Whether its personalized bags of candy or a competitive game of Farkle, Kathy's laugh lights up the room and brings joy to those around her.

School Partnership: Fondy CARES

Children's mental health has been declared a national emergency. While students throughout southeastern Wisconsin are on summer break, "the need for therapy doesn't stop just because school is over," says Taylor, Catholic Charities Community Counseling Therapist.

Catholic Charities "acts as a safety net for those falling through the cracks," says Taylor. Students she serves can reach out to her over summer break to continue counseling virtually or in-person at our office in downtown Fond du Lac.

Through the Fondy CARES program, during the school year a Catholic Charities therapist serves one day a week at Fond du Lac High School as a resource to students, whether it's through appointments or walk-ins.

"Having somebody who is genuinely interested in what they are doing is so important, I am happy to be there for them," explains Taylor.

Catholic Charities' partnership with the Fond du Lac School District began in 2019 when they launched Fondy CARES to increase critical access to school and community based mental health support with the help of local agencies.

Program Spotlight: Pregnancy Support

At 15, LaToya had her first baby. She met our pregnancy and parenting support coordinator, Erika, through a community school partnership at North Division High School in Milwaukee. LaToya had little family support and little knowledge of how to care for herself or a newborn. She began meeting with Erika both in school and at home. Erika provided guidance and support for a healthy pregnancy.

When LaToya was in the hospital alone with baby ready to arrive, she called Erika. Due to pandemic restrictions, Erika was unable to be with her, so she cheered and comforted her through text and phone calls. LaToya delivered a beautiful, healthy baby girl with Erika as her virtual coach. Even when the schools closed, Erika continued to walk with LaToya as a new parent teaching her the skills she needed to show her baby girl how much she is loved.

"Young moms need a warm and comforting, 'I'm here', because a lot of the time, they're not getting that support," says Erika. "I love being accessible to them, to reach them where they are."

Now 18, LaToya is a loving mother to two little ones, a one- and two-year-old. She is a young mother with dreams and ambitions. The support and encouragement she receives from Catholic Charities helps her enjoy the good days and have hope in difficult days.
